





#### **Dear Blue Venture Forum Supporters**

I'm pleased to report that our 2023/24 programming year was our busiest ever. We continued to bring high-value, blue tech focused, programming to thousands of participants, supported dozens of promising blue technology startups through mentorship and matchmaking, and helped investors to better understand the trends shaping blue technology investment while also connecting them with promising startups.

We began the programming year with a special "Future of Blue Technology" event, held in partnership with our friends at the Mystic Seaport Museum, Mystic, Connecticut. The museum's recently redesigned Thompson Exhibition Building, with its views of the Mystic River, served as a tremendous backdrop for the program. The event featured panel discussions that highlighted the cutting-edge work being conducted by industry, start-ups, and research institutions, demonstrations from emerging UUV and USV start-ups, and a networking reception held on the outdoor terrace overlooking the river.

The first ever Blue Venture Investment Summit (BVIS)-Maine was held at the Ocean Gateway, an event space that overlooks Portland's historic waterfront. This program was developed in partnership with the Gulf of Maine Ventures, the entrepreneurship and innovation arm of the Gulf of Maine Research Institute (GMRI). Over 150 attendees heard

from founders, investors, and key resource providers about the current trends in blue tech investing and learned more about Maine's emerging blue tech cluster.

Finally, we held our 9th annual Blue Innovation Symposium (BIS) in Newport, Rhode Island. This year's event had its biggest turnout ever, with more than 300 attendees. Over the course of the three-day event, participants heard from leaders in business, science, and key governmental and academic organizations, including the US Navy, NOAA, BOEM, and the DOE. In addition, we were able to showcase the region's Blue Economy ecosystem with tours of the University of Rhode Island, MITRE, the New Bedford Ocean Cluster, Regent Craft, and UMass Dartmouth's School of Marine & Science Technology. The BIS is becoming one of the premier industry-focused blue technology events in the world.

While we are proud of our successes, we recognize that these great events could not happen without the engagement and commitment of industry, research organizations, our sponsors, board members, staff, and investors. Thank you!

# The Blue Venture Forum A History

In 2022, after the 7th Annual Blue Innovation Symposium (BIS), we determined to create an organization that would further enable the region's blue tech ecosystem. We developed a business plan for the Blue Venture Forum that included developing a platform to connect and educate investors, founders, resource providers about the opportunities in blue tech. With the help of the Van Beuren Charitable Foundation, and the support of the Greater Newport Chamber of Commerce's Newport County Development Council (NCDC), the Blue Venture Forum, Inc. was established as a private non-profit to provide education, mentorship, and matchmaking within the blue tech sector. Today, the BVF organizes the region's only blue tech focused conference, the semi-annual Blue Venture Investment Summit.



## **Our Mission**

We connect blue tech founders, investors, strategic partners, and resource providers via forums such as the Blue Innovation Symposium, the Blue Venture Investment Summit, Piranha Pond Blue Pitch sessions, In-water demonstrations, and other topical events to identify key challenges that need a solution in the blue tech space.

The Blue Venture Forum was founded to connect existing blue technology companies, investors, and resource providers with emerging blue technology firms. This first-of-its-kind forum was created in 2021 to provide scale-up blue technology companies with mentorship, matchmaking with investors and corporates, and connection to resource providers to help them scale and grow their companies. We also provide a valuable service to investors by educating them about the realities of investing in the blue technology sector.

The Blue Venture Forum is a non-profit, incorporated in Rhode Island, that is helping to establish Newport and the region as a global center and hub for blue technology by assisting the region's existing blue technology industry to connect with investors and resource partners and by attracting start-up and scale-up blue tech firms from outside of the state, including Foreign Direct investment, to Newport and the greater Aquidneck Island region. Based on the demographics of the attendees to our events, BVF is having an impact in New England, Canada and beyond.
